The Chairman explained that the Infinigy bid failed to include the solar equipment and installation. They said they were unclear that the bid specification required them to do that based on the layout of the bid specification. The Mid-State bid did include solar equipment and installation based on their reading of the bid specifications. After consult with the County Attorney the two options are; reject both bids, re-advertise and bid again or reject the low bid for not meeting specifications and award to Mid-State. Mr. R. Wilt stated he was all for moving the project forward and getting it done. Mr. Seaman said that Mid-State is a reputable company. If we throw out all bids and start over Mid-State might not bid again. Mr. D. Wilt asked if Infinigy was interested in bidding solar. The Chairman stated yes, but they misunderstood what it was asking. We can't go back and negotiate with the bidder at this point in time. Mr. D. Wilt agreed to move forward.
